

Performance Athlete Support Programme - Terms and Conditions

In addition to the [general university terms and conditions](#), all successful place holders within the Sheffield Hallam University Performance Athlete Support Programme (PASP) are subject to the following terms and conditions.

We reserve the right to withdraw a place in this programme and/or withhold funding to any students who do not meet the requirements laid out in this document or who do not fully engage and participate where required.

Requirements of all students accepted into the Performance Athlete Support Programme

- Within the first 4 weeks of enrolment
 - Attend an induction with the Performance Co-Ordinator
 - Attend a screening/induction with the strength and conditioning service
 - Attend a screening with Physiotherapy support
- Complete a Needs Analysis survey
- Fully engage in the Strength & Conditioning service (usually a minimum of two sessions per week) as agreed in the induction
- Fully engage in Physiotherapy support as determined in your initial screening
- Full Engagement in Sports Psychology, Nutrition & Lifestyle support, as highlighted and agreed with performance Co Ordinator
- Athletes must maintain or improve their sporting performance and satisfy the University with their academic progress. This will be monitored with the support of either the performance coordinator and/or the student support officer
- Play a full and active role in the appropriate Team Hallam club wherever possible, including attending training/matches/events and coaching assistance etc.
- Athletes will be expected to contribute to a university sports club and would normally be expected to represent the University. In some circumstances this requirement may not be appropriate or possible and can be waived by agreement
- Be available for selection for representative student sport through BUCS (Home Nations, EUSA's, WUGS)*
- Fully and regularly inform Team Hallam on sporting progress, including results of competitions and events, national selection, press releases, photographs, or other achievements (via online form)
- Full participation in the performance athlete photo shoot/media day wherever possible.
- Athletes should make themselves available to help in promoting the sporting profile of the University through press coverage and representing the PASP Programme at Open days and other University events where suitable
- Complete Performance Feedback survey each semester
- Sheffield Hallam/PASP promote clean sport across the University. All student athletes are expected to abide by UK Anti-Doping regulations

Data Sharing and Security

- By accepting a place on the Performance Athlete Support Programme, you are agreeing that the University may share reports internally and with local stakeholders that include details of your name and course of study, your sporting achievements and (where applicable) the amount of your scholarship award as well as updates on your academic progress which may be provided by you, or your academic, careers or wellbeing advisors.
- The Department for Sport and Recreation will manage all individual PASP records in compliance with the provisions of the GDPR and any equivalent legislation, regulations, and guidelines, which may be in force in the UK. All data will be held and processed in line with the University [Student Privacy Notice](#).
- The University may refer to the Performance Athlete Support Programme and associated scholarships in publicity materials including social media; local, regional, and national press; and internal communications. You will only be recognised as an individual in publicity and promotion around the scholarship scheme with your full consent for use of personal information.

Performance Athlete Support Programme – Payment details (Scholarships only)

- Scholarships will be paid directly into your bank account in one or two instalments, during one academic year only.
- Once enrolled, you will be invited to complete a **bank details form** so that your payment can be arranged. Upon receipt of this completed form the instalment dates for payment will be confirmed.
- Failure to complete a bank details form upon request will lead to delays in the payment of your scholarship and ultimately may lead to the offer of a scholarship being removed.

Performance Athlete Support Programme Eligibility

Eligibility for the Performance Athlete Support Programme is established by the University's Sports Scholarship Award Panel, in line with the University's Sport Strategy.

Upon receiving confirmation that you have been successfully admitted to the programme (including where applicable, the associated scholarship) the following statements must be true in order that you can take advantage of the scheme:

- You are fully enrolled onto a programme of study at Sheffield Hallam University
- You are a high performing athlete who continues with their sport alongside their studies
