We reserve the right to withdraw this scholarship, the CPD budget and the associated volunteering opportunities from any student who does not meet the requirements laid out in this document or who does not fully engage and participate where required.

Requirements of any student awarded with a TASS EDI Scholarship:

- Complete the application form truthfully and accurately; providing the necessary evidence/further information as/when required.
- Understand that if evidence requirements are not met, this may affect the application outcome.
- Provide a genuine account of past work experiences and of qualifications held.
- Fully engage with the programme of study laid out for MSc Strength and Conditioning Coaching.
- Able to demonstrate appropriate progression through the MSc at relevant checkpoints.
- Commit fully to the voluntary work experience, ensuring all requirements are met.
- Students are expected to engage in a positive manner with support teams and complete any monitoring exercise reasonably required by the TASS National Office in order to facilitate operation of the TASS EDI Scholarship.
- Use your best endeavours to project a favourable image of yourself, Sheffield Hallam University, TASS, SportsAid, and Sport England.
