Data sharing

with looked after and care leaver support teams

The benefits of sharing your data

Withholding your data can sometimes have an impact on the funding and support services you receive.

However the University will not normally share your personal data with a looked after children and care leaver support team within a local authority without your consent. The main exception is that, if asked, we will confirm your enrolment status (eg enrolled, withdrawn, graduated).

By completing the attached consent form, we can share a limited amount of your personal information with a local authority to ensure you receive the full support you are entitled to.

We will only share data with an agency if we are satisfied that it is authorised to act on behalf of the local authority.
