 2. You are a high performing athlete who continues with your sport alongside your studies.

- All athletes must fully abide by any club rules, codes of conduct, or other behavioural codes set out by their Sport Hallam Club and / or their National Governing Body.
- All student athletes must abide by [UK Anti Doping Regulations](#)

Data Sharing:

- Sport Hallam may share personal information regarding the athlete within the multidisciplinary team (coaches, strength and conditioning staff, physios, nutritionists, psychologist, lifestyle practitioner, performance sports coordinator) with the aim of supporting the athlete and to access services.
- The University may share reports and publicity material internally and with stakeholders or press that include details such as name and course of study, sporting achievements and updates on your academic progress.

Funding (If in receipt of a Scholarship):

- Requests for bank details must be met to receive payment. Failure to complete a bank details form upon request will lead to delays in the payment of your scholarship and ultimately may lead to the offer of a scholarship being removed.
